Day 01 –

Greetings from the City of Lights and Romance: Arrival in Paris

The driver will pick you up and take you to your accommodation from the Paris Airport. You have the rest of the day to yourself when you check in. Wander around the lively streets or visit the neighborhood's flea markets, like Rue Cler, Mouffettard, and Bastille. Tour to the 'Top of Europe': Jungfrauoch Excursion

After picking you up from the hotel, the driver will bring you to the Grindelwald Terminal so you may board the Eiger Express to Eigergletscher. Once you get at your location, ride the cogwheel train to Jungfrauoch, also referred to as the "Top of Europe" since it is home to Europe's highest railway station, which is poised majestically. Discover the longest glacier in the Alps by seeing the Ice Palace, admiring the ice sculptures, and stopping by the Sphinx observatory. Later on, spend the night back at your hotel.

Day 07 -

Zurich to Lugano through Lucerne | Lake Lucerne Sightseeing & Cruise

After you check out, the driver will come get you from the hotel and drive you to the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland, Lugano. While traveling, stop briefly at Lucerne to see the Kapell Brucke (Chapel Bridge) and the Lion Monument. Go shopping for chocolates, knives, and Swiss watches. After that, enjoy a breathtaking boat ride around Lake Lucerne, which is encircled by towering mountains. After that, carry on traveling to Lugano where you will spend the night.

Day 08 -

Venice to Padua via Lugano | Experience 'The Floating City of Italy' via Gondola Ride

After you check out, the driver will come to your hotel and drive you to Venice. At the Venice Pier, hop aboard a private boat and savor a meal of Indian cuisine. Navigate the Giudecca Canal and arrive at St. Mark's Square. See St. Mark's Basilica, the Bell Tower, the Clock Tower with its astrological symbols, and the Bridge of Sighs while traveling. Take in a demonstration of Murano glass after which you can take a Gondola ride. Proceed towards Padua, located in Northern Italy, where you will spend the night.

Day 09 -

The driver will pick you up after check-out and drive you to see Florence. To discover more about the rich history of the city, visit the Duomo, Gates to Paradise, Piazza Della Signoria, Palazzo Vecchio, and Ponte Vecchio. Climb to the hilltop Piazzale Michelangelo to take in the expansive views of Florence. See the Leaning Tower of Pisa at the Square of Miracles in Pisa. Afterwards, travel to Tuscany, which is in central Italy, where you will spend the night.

Day 10 -

Travel from Tuscany to Rome and See Vatican City, the Smallest Nation

After leaving the hotel, head to the driver's location for a guided sightseeing tour of Rome and the Vatican City. View a variety of classical sculptures by visiting the Vatican Museum. Discover the Vatican's official residence, the renowned Sistine Chapel. During the tour, be in awe of the sublime grandeur of the Trevi Fountains and St. Peter's Basilica. Visit the Colosseum, an ancient amphitheater, to cap off your tour. After that, you'll be dropped off at your Rome hotel for the night.
