



KEDARNATH



Here is a suggested itinerary for a trip
to Kedarnath





Day 1: Arrival in Haridwar/Rishikesh

- Arrive in Haridwar/Rishikesh, which are the nearest major cities to Kedarnath
- Visit Har Ki Pauri ghat, one of the most sacred places in Haridwar
- Take a dip in the holy Ganges River





Day 2: Travel to Guptkashi

- Take a local bus or hire a taxi to Guptkashi, which is about 200 km from Haridwar/Rishikesh
- Visit the ancient Vishwanath Temple and Ardhnareshwar Temple in Guptkashi





Day 3: Trek to Kedarnath

- Start early in the morning and take a local jeep from Guptkashi to Gaurikund, which is the starting point for the trek
- Trek to Kedarnath, which is about 14 km from Gaurikund
- Reach Kedarnath by late afternoon/evening
- Visit the Kedarnath Temple and seek blessings from Lord Shiva





Day 4: Visit nearby attractions

- Visit the Bhairavnath Temple, which is about 1 km from the Kedarnath Temple
- Trek to Vasuki Tal, which is a beautiful high-altitude lake located about 6 km from Kedarnath.





Day 5: Return to Guptkashi

- Start the return trek to Gaurikund in the morning
- Take a local jeep from Gaurikund to Guptkashi
- Spend the evening exploring Guptkashi and its nearby areas





Day 6: Return to Haridwar/Rishikesh

- Take a local bus or hire a taxi to Haridwar/Rishikesh
- Spend the evening exploring the local markets and restaurants in Haridwar/Rishikesh





Day 7: Departure

- Depart for your next destination
