



Nizhny Novgorod





Day 1:- Arrive in Nizhny Novgorod

- Arrive in Nizhny Novgorod and check into your accommodation.

- If time permits, take a stroll in the Nizhny Novgorod Botanical Garden, known for its diverse plant collections.
