




ROME, ITALY





Day 1:

- Arrive in Rome and check into your hotel.

Day 5:

- Before departing, visit the Capitoline Museums, which house a remarkable collection of ancient Roman sculptures, artifacts, and Renaissance artworks. Enjoy the panoramic views of the Roman Forum from the museum's terrace.
- Explore the vibrant neighborhood of Monti, known for its trendy boutiques, art galleries, and cafes.
- Take a leisurely stroll along the Tiber River and enjoy the views of Rome's bridges.
- If time permits, visit the Domus Aurea, the ruins of Emperor Nero's grand palace, and marvel at its underground chambers and frescoes.
