Detailed Itinerary

Day 01 –

Arrival at Lisbon, the Portuguese capital

The driver will pick you up and take you to your accommodation from the Lisbon airport. You have the rest of the day to yourself when you check in. The city's well-known marketplaces, including the oldest ones, Time Out Market and Ribeira Market, can be explored. There are also a ton of fantastic eateries near these markets.
