

Here's a suggested 4-night, 5-day itinerary for Angkor, Cambodia:







Day 1:

- Arrival and settling in: Arrive at Siem Reap International Airport and transfer to your accommodation in Siem Reap, the gateway to the Angkor Archaeological Park.
