


# MEGHALAYA

Here's a itinerary for a 5 nights/6 days trip to Meghalaya



#### Day 1:

### Arrival in Guwahati and drive to Shillong

- Arrive at Guwahati airport or railway station and meet your driver/guide
- Drive to Shillong, the capital city of Meghalaya
- Visit the Umiam Lake, a beautiful man-made lake offering stunning views of the surrounding hills and valleys
- Check into your hotel in Shillong and rest for the night



## Day 2: Exploring Shillong

- After breakfast, visit the Don Bosco Museum, which showcases the culture and heritage of Northeast India
- Visit the Shillong Peak, the highest point in Shillong offering panoramic views of the city and the Himalayan ranges in the distance
- Visit the Cathedral of Mary Help of Christians, a beautiful church with a mix of Gothic and Roman architecture
- Return to your hotel in the evening and rest

# Day 3:

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### Trek to Double Decker Living Root Bridge

- After breakfast, drive to Tyrna village and start trekking to the Double Decker Living Root Bridge in Nongriat village
- The trek takes about 3-4 hours each way and involves crossing several suspension bridges and climbing up and down stairs
- The Double Decker Living Root Bridge is a unique natural bridge made of the roots of the Ficus elastica tree and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site
- Stay overnight in a homestay in Nongriat village



### Day 4: Exploring Cherrapunjee

- After breakfast, drive to Cherrapunjee, one of the wettest places on earth and known for its beautiful waterfalls and limestone caves
- Visit the Nohkalikai Falls, the tallest plunge waterfall in India and the Seven Sisters Falls, a series of seven cascading waterfalls
- Visit the Mawsmai Caves, a complex of limestone caves with interesting formations
- Return to your hotel in Shillong in the evening and rest



## Day 5:

### Visit Mawlynnong Village and Dawki

- After breakfast, drive to Mawlynnong, a picturesque village known for its cleanliness and natural beauty
- Visit the Living Root Bridge in Mawlynnong, a smaller but equally impressive version of the one in Nongriat
- Drive to Dawki, a small town on the border with Bangladesh, known for its clear blue river and suspension bridge
- Take a boat ride on the Umngot River, which is crystal clear and offers stunning views of the surrounding hills
- Return to your hotel in Shillong in the evening and rest



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## Day 6: Departure

After breakfast, check out of your hotel and drive back to Guwahati for your flight/train back home
