

PORTO, PORTUGAL





Day 1:

- Morning: Start your day by exploring the historic Ribeira district, a UNESCO World Heritage site.
 Wander through the narrow streets, admire the colorful buildings, and visit the iconic Dom Luís I Bridge for panoramic views of the Douro River.

- Evening: Enjoy a wine and food pairing experience in one of Porto's wine bars, where you can taste different Portuguese wines and sample local delicacies.





Day 5:

- Morning: Visit the Casa da Música, a contemporary concert hall known for its striking architecture. Take a guided tour to learn about its design and acoustics.
- Afternoon: Explore the trendy neighborhood of Cedofeita. Browse through the independent shops, visit the contemporary art galleries, and enjoy a coffee in one of the stylish cafes.
