



# Day 1:

- Arrival in Vienna: Start your journey by arriving in Vienna and checking into your accommodation.
- Historic Center: Begin your exploration in the historic center of Vienna, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit St. Stephen's Cathedral, an iconic symbol of the city. Take a walk along the Graben and Kärntner Strasse, two famous shopping streets.

### Day 2:

- Schönbrunn Palace: Take a trip to Schönbrunn Palace, another UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore the imperial summer residence and its beautiful gardens. Visit the state rooms, the Gloriette, and the Tiergarten, the oldest zoo in the world.
- Belvedere Palace: Visit the Belvedere Palace, a
   Baroque masterpiece. Admire the stunning
   architecture and explore the art collection,
   including works by Gustav Klimt, such as "The Kiss."
- Prater Park: End your day by visiting the Prater, a large park with an amusement park. Take a ride on the iconic Giant Ferris Wheel, enjoy the various attractions, or simply relax in the green surroundings.





# Day 3:

- Museum Quarter: Explore the Museum Quarter, one
  of the largest cultural complexes in the world. Visit
  the Leopold Museum, which houses an extensive
  collection of Austrian art, including works by Egon
  Schiele and Gustav Klimt. Explore other museums
  in the area, such as the Kunsthistorisches Museum
  or the Museum of Natural History.
- Naschmarkt: Visit the Naschmarkt, a vibrant openair market. Stroll through the stalls selling fresh produce, spices, and local delicacies. Enjoy a meal at one of the many international restaurants or cafes in the area.





# Day 4:

- Vienna State Opera: Take a guided tour of the Vienna State Opera, one of the world's most renowned opera houses. Learn about its history, architecture, and enjoy a behind-the-scenes glimpse of the stage.
- Albertina Museum: Visit the Albertina Museum, home to an extensive collection of art, including works by Monet, Picasso, and Dürer. Don't miss the opportunity to explore the stunning State Rooms and the views from the museum's terrace.
- Stadtpark: Take a leisurely walk in Stadtpark, a beautiful park known for its famous Johann Strauss monument. Admire the sculptures, ponds, and enjoy the peaceful atmosphere.
